## to amend the Assam Opium Prohibition Act, 1947

Preamble. Whereas it is expedient to amend further the Assam Opium Prohibition Act, 1947 (Assam Act XXIII of 1947), hereinafter called the Principal Act, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted in the twenty-fourth year of the Republic of India as follows:—

Short title, extent and commencement.

- 1. (1) This Act may be called the Assam Opium Prohibition (Amendment) Act, 1973.
  - (2) It shall have like extent as the Principal Act.
  - (3) It shall come into force on the first day of April, 1973.

- 32. (1) The State Prohibition Council may, by notification in the official Gazette, constitute for any district or part thereof and for such period as it may deem fit, Prohibition Committees each consisting of two or more non-official residents of the district. The State Prohibition Council may also, by like notification, dissolve or reconstitute such Prohibition Committees.
- (2) The duties to be performed by the State Prohibition Council and the Prohibition Committees and the relation between the council and the Committees and the relation of such Committees to the Council shall be such as may be prescribed.
