# (Received the assent of the Governor on the 29th March 1973) THE ASSAM APPROPRIATION (VOTE-ON-ACCOUNT) ACT, 1973

[Published in the Assam Gazette, Extraordinary, dated the 30th March 1973]

An Act

to provide for the withdrawal of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam to the service of a Part of the financial year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1974

Be it hereby enacted in the Twenty-fourth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

Short title 1. This Act may be called the Assam Appropriation and comand (Vote-on-Account) Act, 1973. The Act shall come mencement. into force with effect from 1st April, 1973.

Withdrawal 2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the of Rs.58,41, State of Assam, there may be withdrawn sums not 02,300 out of exceeding those specified in column (3) of the Schedule dated Fund amounting in the aggregate to the sum of Rupees of the State fifty-eight crores, forty-one lakbs two thousand and of Assam for three hundred towards defraying the several charges the financial which will come in course of payment during the period of three months beginning on the first day of April, 1973 in respect of the services specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

Appropriation. 3. The sums authorised to be withdrawn from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1974.
