No.LJL.59/77/2.—The following Act of the Assam Legislative Assembly which received the assent of the Governor is hereby published for general information.

ASSAM ACT XII OF 1977

(Received the assent of the Governor on 11th May 1977)

THE ASSAM APPROPRIATION (No. II) ACT, 1977.

An

to provide for the withdrawal of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam to the Service of the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1978.

Be it enacted in the Twenty-eighth Year of the Republic of India as follows :-

Short title and commencement.

- 1. (1) This Act may be called the Assam Appropriation (No. II) Act, 1977.
 - (2) It shall come into force with effect from 1st April, 1977.

Withdrawal of Rs. year 1977-78.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam, there 328,87,68,700 out may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column (3) of the Consolidation of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate linclusive of the sum specified of the Consolidated Fund of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate [inclusive of the sum specified to the State of Assam in column (3) to the Assam Appropriation (Vote-on-Account) for the Financial Act, 1977] to the sum of Rupees three hundred twenty-eight crores eighty-seven la'ths sixty-eight thousand and seven hundred towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1978 in respect of the services specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

Appropriation.

3. The sums, authorised to be withdrawn from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1978.
