No. LGL. 66/78/4.—The following Act of the Assam Legislative Assembly which received the assent of the Governor is hereby published for general information.

#### ASSAM ACT II OF 1978

(Received the assent of the Governor on the 30th March 1978.)

THE ASSAM APPROPRIATION (VOTE ON ACCOUNT)
ACT, 1978

#### An Act

to provide for the withdrawal of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam to the services of a part of the financial year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1979.

Be it enacted in the Twenty-ninth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

Short title 1. (1) This Act may be called the Assam Appropriation and com-(Vote-on-Account) Act, 1978.

(2) It shall come into force with effect from 1st April, 1978.

Withdrawal 2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Rs.1,02,37, of Assam, there may be withdrawn sums not exceeding those 30,300 out of specified in column (3) of the Schedule amounting in the the Consolidated Fund aggregate to the sum of Rupees one hundred two crores, thirty-seven lakhs, thirty thousand and three hundred only towards of Assam for defraying the several charges which will come in course of the financial payment during the period of three months beginning on first year 1978-79. day of April, 1978 in respect of the services specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

Appropria 3. The sums, authorised to be withdrawn from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1979.
