to provide for the withdrawal of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam to the service of a Part of the financial year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1972

Be it hereby enacted in the Twenty-second Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

Short title, 1. This Act may be called the Assam Appropriation and commencement. (Vote on Account) Act, 1971. The Act shall commencement into force with effect from 1st April, 1971.

Withdrawal 2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the of Rs. State of Assam, there may be withdrawn sums not out of the exceeding those specified in column (3) of the Schedule Consolidated amounting in the aggregate to the sum of rupees Fund of the sixty-six crores, forty-six lakhs, fourteen thousand State of and four hundred towards defraying the several financial year charges which will come in course of payment during 1971-72. the period of three months beginning on the first day of April, 1971 in respect of the services specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

Appropriation.

3. The sums authorised to be withdrawn from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes and expressed in the Schedule in relation to the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1972.
