ASSAM ACT III OF 1979

(Received the assent of the Governor on 30th March, 1979) THE ASSAM APPROPRIATION (NO. II) ACT, 1979

Act

to provide for the withdrawal of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam to the service of the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1980.

It is hereby enacted in the Thirtieth Year of the Republic of India as follows:

Short title and commencement.

1.(1) This Act may be called the Assam Appropriation (No. II) Act, 1979.

(2) The Act shall come into force with

effect from 1st April, 1979.

Withdrawal of Rs. 438,83,65,600 out of the Consolidated Fund of the State 1979-80.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam, there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in of Assam for the column (3) of the Schedule amounting in the year aggregate to the sum of Rupees four hundred thirty eight crores, eightythree lakhs, sixty-five thousand and six hundred towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1980 in respect of the services specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

Appropriation.

3. The sums, authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1980.
