THE ASSAM AMUSEMENTS AND BETTING TAX (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1979

Act

further to amend the Assam Amusements and Betting Tax Act, 1939.

Preamble. Whereas it is expedient further to amend the Assam Amusements and VI of 1939. Betting Tax Act, 1939, hereinafter called the principal Act, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted in the Thirtieth Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

PUBLISHED BY AUTHOMITY

- Short title, 1. (1) This Act may be called the extent and 1. (1) This Act may be called the Assam Amusements and Betting Tax (Amendment)

 Act, 1979.
 - (2) It shall have like extent as the principal Act.
 - (3) It shall come into force from the 1st day of April, 1979.

Amendment 2. In the principal Act, in Section of Section 3, in sub-section (1), after the existing Act VI of proviso, the following shall be inserted as second proviso, namely:—

"Provided further that no tax shall be charged and levied in respect of any delegat Covernor is hereby published for general information
