No.LGL.258/79/15.—The following Act of the Aesam Legislative Assembly which received the assent of the Governor is hereby published for general information.

#### ASSAM ACT XIII OF 1979

(Received the assent of the Governor on 18th November, 1979)

THE ASSAM APPROPRIATION (NO. III) ACT, 1979

An

Act

to provide for the withdrawal of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam to the Service of the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1980.

It is hereby enacted in the Thirtieth Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

1. This Act may be called the Assam Appropriation (No.III) Act, 1979.

Withdrawal of Rs. 18,10,62,905 of the State of Assam for the Financial year 1979-80.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund Rs. 18,10,62,905 from and out of the Of the State of Assam, there may be paid and Consolidated Fund applied sums not exceeding those specified in column (3) of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of Rupees Eighteen crore ten lakhs sixty-two thousand nine hundred and five towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1980 in respect of the services specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

Appropriation.

3. The sums, authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1980.
