## ASSAM ACT II OF 1970

## (Received the assent of the Governor on the 31st March, 1970)

THE ASSAM APPROPRIATION (VOTE ON ACCOUNT)
ACT, 1970

[Published in the Assam Gazette, Extraordinary, dated the 1st April, 1970]

An Act

to provide for the withdrawal of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam to the service of a Part of the financial year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1971.

Be it hereby enacted in the Twenty-First Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

Short title and commencement. (Vote on Account) Act, 1970. The Act shall come into force with effect from 1st April, 1970.

Withdrawal 2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam there may be withdrawn sums not out of the exceeding those specified in column (3) of the Schedule Consolidated amounting in the aggregate to the sum of rupees Fund of the Sixty-eight crores, ninety lakhs, thirty-five thousand and Assam for three hundred towards defraying the several charges the financial which will come in course of payment during the period year 1970-71 of three months beginning on the first day of April, 1970 in respect of the services specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

Appropriation.

3. The sums authorised to be withdrawn from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1971.
