Preamble.

Whereas it is expedient further to amend the Assam Assam Act Amusements and Betting Tax Act, 1939 hereinafter VI 1939. called the principal Act, in the manner hereinafter

It is hereby enacted in the Twentieth Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

1. (1) This Act may be called the Assam Amuseextent and ments and Betting Tax (Second Amendment) Act, commencement.

- (2) It shall have the like extent as the principal
- (3) It shall be deemed to have come into force from the 1st April, 1968.

2. For sub-section (1) of Section 3 (A) of the prin-Amendment section cipal Act, the following shall be substituted, namely— 3A of Assam Act VI of 1939.

"(1) In the case of cinematograph exhibitions, in addition to the entertainments tax under section 3, there shall be levied and paid to the State Government of Assam for every show a tax at the rate of ten per centum of the total payment for admission received excluding the amount of tax payable under the Act or Rupees ten whichever is less.
