to provide for the withdrawal of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam to the service of the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1968

It is hereby enacted in the Eighteenth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

Short title 1. (1) This Act may be called the Assam Appromencement. priation (No.II) Act, 1967.

(2) This Act shall come into force with effect from 1st April, 1967.

Withdrawal of Rs. 2,41,41,94,900 from a n d out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column (3) of the cout of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate [inclusive of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam Appropriation (Vote on Account) Act, 1967] Assam for to the sum of rupees two hundred and forty-one crores, forty-one lakhs, ninety-four thousand and nine hundred cial year towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1968 in respect of the services specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1968.
