
to provide for the withdrawal of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam to the service of a part of the financial year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1968

Be it hereby enacted in the Eighteenth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

Short title 1. This Act may be called the Assam Appropriaand comtion (Vote on Account) Act, 1967. The Act shall mencement come into force with effect from 1st April, 1967.

Withdrawal of State of Assam there may be withdrawn sums not out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam there may be withdrawn sums not out of the Consolidatamounting in the aggregate to the sum of rupees fiftyed Fund of eight crores, sixty lakhs, fifty-seven thousand and eight the State of hundred towards defraying the several charges which Assam for the financial year three months beginning on the first day of April, 1967-68.
