THE ASSAM APPROPRIATION (No.IV) ACT, 1966

Act

to provide for the withdrawal of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam to the service of the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1967.

It is hereby enacted in the Seventeenth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

Short title 1. This Act may be called the Assam Appropriation (No. IV) Act, 1966.

Withdrawal of State of Assam there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column (3) of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam for lakhs, seventy-three thousand, three hundred and ninety-six rupees towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of the financial year 1966-67. day of March, 1967 in respect of the services specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

Appropriation.

3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1967.
